Hold up ... why is a design studio talking about ChatGPT and writing?


We are small and mighty. Our client partners are small and mighty.

What is ChatGPT?

In a short sentence describe chatgpt to a non-technical person.

ChatGPT is a digital assistant that can understand and generate human-like text based on the information it's been trained on.

ChatGPT may produce inaccurate information about people, places, or facts. ChatGPT August 3 Version





What is ChatGPT Cont.

- Website and service https://chat.openai.com
- Natural Language model designed to understand and output human-like text through a "Chat" interface
- Free and paid offerings
- It is "Trained" on a wealth of publicly available content up to 2021.

Let's look at an example of drafting an article. My goal is to save me time by giving me some writing I can revise to make my own.

We start with a prompt.

Your key to better ChatGPT responses is to develop your prompting skills.

- 1. Context
- 2. Audience
- 3. Requirements





Prompt: Context

What is the subject matter?

- Background information: We are a nonprofit that provides programming for middle and high school youth ...
- Specific content to work with: Here is an example of a social post we used before and liked ..., here is a introductory paragraph we want to expand
- Purpose & goal: To inspire readers to volunteer, to donate, to register, to download, ...





Context Summary

"Teach" ChatGPT about

- the subject matter
- the big picture
- the purpose





Prompt: Audience

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Fun Audience Example

Define breakfast to a corporate executive.

Requirements Summary

"Tell" ChatGPT what you want it to do

- the type of writing
- the length
- the style





A good prompt FTW!

A good thoughtful prompt = a far better response from ChatGPT.

In many ways, this is akin to how you might collaborate and delegate a task to another person.

- 1. Context
- 2. Audience
- 3. Requirements

What about the quality?

Here are some things to consider regarding the quality of ChatGPT's writing.

- "Training" content dated 2021
- ChatGPT does not browse the web
- Potential for plagiarism
- Writing style tends to be a little wordy/dense
- Potential for bias & stereotypes
- Hallucinations
- Lack of deep knowledge and skilled understanding
- Lack of empathy and personal/human touch






ChatGPT, a tool for you the expert

ChatGPT is helpful as a writing and content creator's resource when you are knowledgeable enough on the topic that you can revise or at least vouch for quality.

- Use ChatGPT to plan, think, and draft ... not write final copy
- Don't assume ChatGPT is "right" and that what it shares is "accurate"
- Carefully assess quality to reflect your organizations brand well
- Revise to add your organization's style and "humanize" the writing





What next?

Whether you plan to try ChatGPT for the first time or are ready to take your experience to the next level. Keep in mind ...

- Your prompts are your superpower
- Context, Audience, and Requirements
- Experiment and try to find those prompts and situations where ChatGPT can save you time.
- You be the expert, let ChatGPT assist.
- Know that the skills you develop with ChatGPT will carry over to many other A.I. powered features and opportunities.






Some general every day tips

- Save the prompts that work well.
- A.I. memory is short and sometimes too much chat and revision can get off track.
- Be careful what you share with ChatGPT ... personal and identifiable information, confidential information, and the like should likely be kept out of ChatGPT without further research and care into current state of privacy.
- Prompts, prompts! There are prompt suggestions and formulas everywhere.
